

Ordinance No. 1935

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1870 TO REDESIGNATE FUNDS FROM THE PUBLIC WORKS GARAGE TO PURCHASE FIRE APPARATUS.

WHEREAS, the City adopted Ordinance 1870 on January 27, 2003, issuing \$5,525,000.00 Infrastructure Bonds, 2003 Series A, and;

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1870 specified one of the uses of the funds to be a Public Works Garage, and;

WHEREAS, the City only currently needs funding for a Public Works Garage for the architectural design portion only, and:

WHEREAS, the City requires immediate funding to purchase additional fire apparatus,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that Ordinance 1870 is amended to include fire apparatus as an additional use of the bond proceeds.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on the _____ day of _____, 2005, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the _____ day of _____, 2005.
