

ORDINANCE NO. 1995

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2006 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL HIGHWAY USER TAX FUNDS THAT WERE RELEASED TO THE CITY TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE FUNDS

WHEREAS, additional Highway User Tax funds were released to the City; and

WHEREAS, there are a number of areas on various City streets in which there are indications of pavement failure; and

WHEREAS, the life expectancy of these streets can be extended if these areas of pavement failure are repaired through short-term repairs by the Street Branch personnel and long-term repairs through the street reconstruction program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the City's Fiscal Year 2006 General Fund budget be, and is hereby, amended as follows:

- 1) Add to the Fiscal Year 2006 Highway User Tax Account (01000-424201) the sum of \$96,715;
- 2) Add to the Fiscal Year 2006 Public Works - Street budget the sum of \$17,060;
- 3) Add to the Fiscal Year 2006 Public Works - Engineering budget the sum of \$79,655;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on the 8th day of May, 2006, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the 22nd day of May, 2006.
