ORDINANCE NO. 2001

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY TO AMEND SECTION 15.32.010 OF THE SALISBURY MUNICIPAL CODE TO PERMIT THE SALISBURY CITY COUNCIL TO AMEND THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR PLUMBING PERMITS BY RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL FROM TIME TO TIME.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury has adopted the Maryland State Plumbing/Gas Code;

WHEREAS, the Salisbury City Council desires to amend the Maryland State Plumbing/Gas Code to allow the Salisbury City Council to adopt a fee schedule for plumbing permits by Resolution of the Council from time to time;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the City Council of the City of Salisbury, in regular session, that Section 15.32.010 of the Salisbury Municipal Code shall be amended as follows:

15.32.10 Adoption of Plumbing Code

A. The Maryland State Plumbing/Gas Code – COMAR 09.20.01, which is hereby incorporated by reference, be, and is hereby adopted as the Plumbing Code of the City of Salisbury in the State of Maryland, for the control of buildings and structures as herein provided, and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of the Code of Salisbury are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part thereof. The Plumbing Code so adopted is known as the “Salisbury Practical Plumbing Code 2005.”

B. The following additions and deletions are made to the Maryland State Plumbing/Gas Code:

1. Section 1.10.1 Fees Schedule shall be deleted in its entirety. Plumbing permit fees shall be set by Resolution of the Council from time to time.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, that the changes set forth in this Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on the 12th day of June, 2006, and having been published as required by law, in the meantime, was finally passed by the Council on the _____ day of _____, 2006.
