

ORDINANCE NO. 2002

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2006 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO COVER THE POPLAR HILL MANSION FOUNDATION REPAIR PROJECT

WHEREAS, in 2002, it was determined that the foundation and chimneys of Poplar Hill Mansion needed to be repaired; and

WHEREAS, the Salisbury City Council budgeted \$15,500 in Fiscal Year 2003, \$15,500 in Fiscal Year 2004, \$15,000 in Fiscal Year 2005, and \$15,000 in Fiscal Year 2006 to fund this repair project; and

WHEREAS, the repair project has been bid out, approved by the Maryland Historical Trust, and is ready to begin; and

WHEREAS, the funds budgeted in the previous fiscal years must be added to the current year's budget so that the funds for this project are available;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland that the City's Fiscal Year 2006 General Fund budget be, and is hereby, amended as follows:

- 1) Add to the Fiscal Year 2006 General Fund Unbudgeted Surplus Account (01000-469810) the sum of \$46,000;
- 2) Add to the Fiscal Year 2006 Poplar Hill Mansion budget the sum of \$46,000 (Building Account – 19600-577015).

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Salisbury City Council that this Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on the _____ day of _____, 2006, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the _____ day of _____, 2006.
