

ORDINANCE NO. 2011

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING AN AMENDMENT OF THE FY 06 BUDGET TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM THE PURCHASING DEPARTMENT TO THE LEGAL DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF OUTSTANDING LEGAL BILLS.

WHEREAS, bills from the City Attorney exceeded the appropriation for the Legal Department for FY 06; and

WHEREAS, there are funds available in the Purchasing Department Budget for FY 06 that will not be spent;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the City's Fiscal Year 2006 General Fund budget be, and is hereby, amended as follows:

- 1) Decrease the Purchasing Department budget by the sum of \$38,000
- 2) Increase the Legal Department budget by the sum \$38,000

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on the ____ day of _____, 2006, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the ____ day of _____, 2006.
