

**CITY OF SALISBURY  
ORDINANCE NO. 2029**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY GRANTING A RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT ACROSS CITY OWNED LAND LOCATED ON NAYLOR MILL ROAD, SALISBURY, MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, Verizon Maryland, Incorporated, has requested that the City grant a right-of-way easement to construct, operate, maintain, modify and replace telecommunication and electric systems across City owned land located on Naylor Mill Road, as shown on the attached plat; and

WHEREAS, Verizon Maryland, Incorporated, will pay to the City the sum of \$3,000.00 in consideration for said easement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

1. For the purposes and reasons hereinabove set forth, the City of Salisbury be, and hereby is, authorized to grant unto Verizon Maryland, Incorporated, a right-of-way easement to construct, operate, maintain, modify and replace telecommunication and electric systems, including the necessary poles, braces, anchors and guys, conduit, manholes, cable, wires, pads, cabinets, and fixtures upon, under, over and through the property of the City of Salisbury located on Naylor Mill Road, as shown on the attached map, provided that Verizon Maryland, Incorporated, pay the sum of \$3,000.00 to the City of Salisbury in consideration therefore.
2. The City Solicitor be and hereby is directed to prepare and submit for execution by the City of Salisbury an appropriate deed for the purposes aforesaid.
3. This Ordinance shall take effect from the date of its final passage.
