

ORDINANCE NO. 2066

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2009 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE SURPLUS FUNDS TO COMPLETE THE FISCAL YEAR 2008 REPAVING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the FY08 paving contract was terminated by the City due to the unexpected increase in the price of asphalt; and

WHEREAS, as a result of this action, appropriated funds totaling \$242,158 were not expended in FY08; and

WHEREAS, the paving contract has been rewritten to provide an escalation clause for the price of asphalt; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works requests that the unexpended funds from the FY08 budget be appropriated for the Fiscal Year 2009 budget to provide the needed funds to complete the Fiscal Year 2008 Black Top Program Contract.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the City's Fiscal Year 2009 General Fund budget be, and is hereby, amended as follows:

- (1) Increase in the current surplus account for the General Fund (01000-469810) by the sum of \$242,158

- (2) Increase the Public Works-Resource Management/Engineering by the sum of \$242,158

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on the _____ day of _____, 2008 and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the _____ day of _____, 2008.
