Attached is a copy of the application requesting Enterprise Zone designation from Daniel M. O'Connell II of Pigg, Krahl, Stern & Co., P.A. on behalf of the Perdue Poultry Research & Development Facility. I have reviewed this application and, to the best of my knowledge, this establishment meets all of the qualifications to be so designated. This property is located within the boundaries of the City's Enterprise Zone. Perdue Farms Inc. is the owner of the property and, as such, would be the entity to take advantage of the property tax credit, as they have invested more than \$50,000 in the property recently. They also qualify for the income tax credit because of the jobs they have created since locating to the zone.

I recommend that the City Council adopt the attached resolution designating Perdue Farms Inc., located at 2110 Industrial Parkway, eligible to receive the benefits of the Enterprise Zone.

The Mayor concurs with this recommendation.

As a reminder, companies that are declared eligible for enterprise zone benefits are able to receive both income tax and property tax benefits for ten years. The purpose of this program is to encourage industries to locate in areas identified as enterprise zones and to reinvest in such properties.

RESOLUTION NO. 1179

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND DECLARING THAT PERDUE FARMS INCORPORATED, LOCATED AT 2110 INDUSTRIAL PARKWAY (PERDUE POULTRY RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT FACILITY), IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE ENTERPRISE ZONE BENEFITS

WHEREAS the City of Salisbury, Maryland and Wicomico County created an Enterprise Zone on June 6, 1983 for the purpose of encouraging economic development of the area encompassed within the boundaries of such zone; and

WHEREAS the Enterprise Zone was created under authority granted by the State of Maryland; and

WHEREAS the State Code permits certain benefits to be extended to businesses that locate or expand in the Enterprise Zone provided that they meet certain standards; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury and Wicomico County have also established certain standards, which must be met in order for a business to be deemed eligible to receive Enterprise Zone benefits; and

WHEREAS, Perdue Poultry Research & Development Facility, located at 2110 Industrial Parkway, meets the standards set forth in the State Code and in local regulations to be eligible to receive Enterprise Zone benefits; and

WHEREAS, Daniel M. O'Connell II of Pigg, Krahl, Stern & Co., P.A., representing Perdue Farms Inc., has requested that the company be designated as eligible for Enterprise Zone benefits due to their investment in the property and job creation since they located in the zone at 2110 Industrial Parkway;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland that Perdue Farms Incorporated be designated as eligible to receive the benefits of the Enterprise Zone effective upon the adoption of this resolution.

The above Resolution was introduced and read and passed at the regular meeting of the Salisbury City Council on the 20th day of December, 2004.
