A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING FUNDS IN COOPERATION WITH THE MARYLAND OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY TO PROVIDE FOR OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT TO POLICE OFFICERS PARTICIPATING IN DWI ENFORCEMENT TO REDUCE THE OCCURRENCE OF DRIVERS OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL AND OR DRUGS.

WHEREAS, the Maryland Office of Highway Safety and the Salisbury Police Department will cooperate successfully in serving the people of Salisbury/Wicomico County and;

WHEREAS, grant funding has been designated for proactive enforcement efforts;

WHEREAS, the use of overtime funds will allow increased police presence for DWI enforcement;
