The Building Board of Appeals is established in Section 112 of the International Building Code (2000 Edition), for the purpose to hear and decide appeals of orders, decisions or determinations made by the building official relative to the application and interpretation Building and Fire Prevention Code. An appeal is based on a claim that the true intent of the code has been

incorrectly interpreted, the provisions of the code not fully apply, or that an equally good or better form of construction is proposed.

The qualifications for members of the Board includes the professions of structural engineering, architecture, fire protection engineering and a member that is a developer or general contractor.

With this in mind, I recommend that Andrew Bradley be appointed to the City of Salisbury Building Board of Adjustments & Appeals for a period as determined by the Mayor and City Council.
