A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH A GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION FOR THE COLLABORATIVE SUPERVISION AND FOCUSED ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE CHURCH STREET AREA.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury submitted a grant application requesting continuance of funding under the Collaborative Supervision and Focused Enforcement Program to the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury's grant application was approved by the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention to provide funding for the following programs; and

Teens On The Go/Grace United Methodist Church	\$ 3,000
Rahab's Place/Rahab Services for Prostitutes	<u>\$ 1,300</u>
Total Award	\$75,693
