Please forward this information on to the City Council so it may be placed on the agenda for the meeting on July 11, 2005. Please let me know if you have any questions.

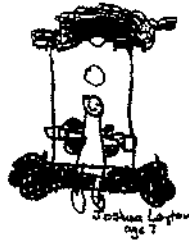
