

RESOLUTION NO. 1291

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM MARYLAND STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION FOR PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE FACILITIES IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Maryland State Highway Administration has a multi-year Transportation Enhancement Program for making pedestrian-and-bicycle-facilities improvements; and,

WHEREAS, the Maryland State Highway Administration Transportation Enhancement Program provides grant funds for the City of Salisbury to use in specific areas; and,

WHEREAS, the pedestrian-and-bicycle-facilities improvements to be constructed include:

1. The west side of the existing portion of the Northeast Collector Road, constructed by Wicomico County, Maryland and annexed by the City of Salisbury, Maryland, between the north side of US Route 50 at Beaglin Park Drive to a point approximately 1,365 feet northeasterly to the previous City/County line being the same south end of the Northeast Collector Road, Phase 2 portion, presently being constructed by the City of Salisbury under Contract No. 10-04-NECR (2),
2. The west side of the Northeast Collector Road, Phase 2 portion, presently being constructed by the City of Salisbury, Maryland and Maryland State Highway Administration, approximately 2211 feet between the previous City/County line and south side of MD Route 346 (Old Ocean City Road); and,

WHEREAS, the entire estimated cost for this segment is approximately \$450,000; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury agrees to provide 50% matching funds and/or services, in the amount of \$225,000, for these pedestrian-and-bicycle-facilities improvements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland to accept these Maryland State Highway pedestrian-and-bicycle-facilities improvements funds, in the amount of \$225,000, for the betterment of the City and its residents.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and read and passed at the regular meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on this 22nd day of August, 2005, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
