A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING STATE GRANT FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH A BYRNE MEMORIAL GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION TO FUND A CIVILIAN POSITION OF CRIME DATA ANALYST AND PROVIDE CRIME PREVENTION INFORMATION TO CITIZENS IN THE COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, state funds were awarded in a Byrne Memorial Grant by the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention to fund a Mobile Crime Analysis/Prevention program; and

WHEREAS, the grant funding will be used to employ a Crime Data Analyst to enhance the Salisbury Police Department's current mobile network; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Mobile Crime Analysis/Prevention project to reduce "Part I" crimes and provide crime prevention information to citizens in the community, thereby increasing our level of service to residents of the City of Salisbury.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the awarded State grant funds in the amount of \$23,400 be accepted and used to fund a Mobile Crime Analysis/Prevention project.
