

RESOLUTION NO. 1399

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND TO ESTABLISH TEMPORARY NO PARKING ZONES ON THE NORTH SIDE OF TROOPER'S WAY AND THE EAST SIDE OF DICKERSON LANE IN SALISBURY, MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, community concerns have been raised regarding the portion of the roadway available to traffic on Trooper's Way and the sight distances for approaching traffic when exiting Trooper's Way onto Dickerson Lane;

WHEREAS, the congestion and sight distance problems are due to the parking of trucks and vans related to a construction project at Trooper's Way and Dickerson Lane and are temporary in nature;

WHEREAS, adequate space for construction related parking is available on the south side of Trooper's Way and on the west side of Dickerson Lane.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that temporary No Parking zones be established on the north side of Trooper's Way between Dickerson Lane and the first residential driveway in the Villas at Avalon and on the east side of Dickerson Lane between the driveways nearest the Outback Restaurant and Hughes Supply until the completion of the current construction project.

THIS RESOLUTION was duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on April 24, 2006 and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
