

RESOLUTION NO. 1421

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH A GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR’S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION FOR THE COLLABORATIVE SUPERVISION AND FOCUSED ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE CHURCH STREET CSAFE AREA.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury submitted a grant application requesting supplemental funding under the Collaborative Supervision and Focused Enforcement (CSAFE) Program to the Governor’s Office of Crime Control and Prevention; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury’s grant application was approved by the Governor’s Office of Crime Control and Prevention to provide funding for the Wicomico County/Salisbury/Church Street – Gang Intervention initiative in the amount of \$12,000; and

WHEREAS, the grant was awarded to the City of Salisbury;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this 10th day of July that the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland does hereby accept the funds awarded from the Governor’s Office of Crime Control and Prevention; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Mayor Barrie P. Tilghman is authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents required for receipt of said funds.
