

Resolution No. 1432

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING STATE GRANT FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE CEASE FIRE COUNCIL TO ENHANCE PUBLIC SAFETY IN SALISBURY, MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, State funds were awarded by the Maryland Cease Fire Council for programs which address proactive efforts in reducing incidents of violent crimes involving handguns; and

WHEREAS, the use of these funds will provide reimbursement for Personnel (overtime) (\$32,500), Contractual Services (DNA/GSR testing by a private lab) (\$9,715) and Equipment (Electrostatic Dust Print Lifter, Crime Light and Evidence Drying Cabinet) (\$8,181.00) to be used by officers assigned to the Salisbury Police Department Project Exile; and

WHEREAS, this program will specifically address firearms reduction efforts, thus enhancing the quality of life in Salisbury, Maryland.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the awarded State Grant Funds in the amount of \$50,396 be accepted and used to address proactive efforts in reducing incidents of violent crimes involving handguns.
