

**RESOLUTION NO. 1595**

A RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY  
TO REMOVE RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING FOR MIDDLE BOULEVARD  
BETWEEN WAVERLY DRIVE AND SMITH STREET.

WHEREAS, a majority of the residents on Middle Boulevard between Waverly Drive and Smith Street have indicated via petition that they do not want parking restrictions for residences on this street; and

WHEREAS, these residents have expressed an interest in removing residential permit parking for residences on Middle Boulevard between Waverly Drive and Smith Street, and

WHEREAS, these residents do not believe that day and evening functions at Salisbury University or other events create a parking hardship on this street;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland to remove residential permit parking restriction for residences on Middle Boulevard between Waverly Drive and Smith Street.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and read and passed at the regular meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of November 2007, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
