

RESOLUTION NO. 1606

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND
ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF THREE (3) UTILITY VEHICLES FOR USE BY
THE SALISBURY FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the volunteer members of the Salisbury Fire Department constantly seek to enhance the department's capabilities in the effective and efficient delivery of public safety services through their contributions of equipment and apparatus to the City; and,

WHEREAS, funds appropriated to the Volunteer Corporations have been expended by each of those Corporations to purchase three (3) utility vehicles to be donated to the City of Salisbury Fire Department for inclusion in its inventory of emergency vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, the new vehicles will replace aging vehicles currently in use by the Department that will be removed from active service through the City's surplus of equipment processes; and,

WHEREAS, both the Fire Chief and the Mayor have recommended that the City graciously accept the donation of these vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, the City's gift policy requires that such a gift can only be accepted with the approval of City Council,

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the City of Salisbury accepts these gifts and expresses its sincere appreciation to the entire Volunteer Corporate membership of the Salisbury Fire Department for their generous gift of the vehicles listed below for inclusion in the department's inventory of emergency vehicles:
