

Resolution No. 1646

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING FUNDS TO PROVIDE FOR OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT TO THE SALISBURY POLICE DEPARTMENT, WHO IN COOPERATION AND AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL WILL PARTICIPATE AND CONDUCT JOINT OPERATIONS FOR OPERATION TALON.

WHEREAS, Operation Talon is a special Presidential law enforcement initiative, which is being led by the Office of Inspector General and carried out in conjunction with State, local and Social Service agencies across the country; and

WHEREAS, the Salisbury Police Department agrees to cooperate in a comprehensive law enforcement effort to identify and apprehend fleeing felons, who have or are receiving Food Stamp benefits in violation of 7U.S.C.S2015(k); and

WHEREAS, the Salisbury Police Department conducts appropriate law enforcement operations and engages in traditional methods of investigation to effectuate prosecutions before the courts of the United States and/or the State of Maryland; and

WHEREAS, the Salisbury Police Department will gather intelligence relating to fleeing felons, food stamp fraud, money laundering and related violation of the law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that grant funds in the amount of \$5,000.00 be accepted and used for overtime reimbursement to accomplish the objectives of this joint law enforcement operation "Operation Talon", as requested by the Office of Inspector General, Northeast Region.
