

RESOLUTION NO. 1658

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF \$6,000 FROM THE CITY'S CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND THE CITY'S SHARE OF A JOINT PROJECT WITH THE COUNTY FOR PRELIMINARY WORK FOR A MIXED-USE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT IN DOWNTOWN SALISBURY WITH THE LIBRARY AS A KEY COMPONENT

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Wicomico County Free Library desires to relocate the library to a larger facility in downtown Salisbury; and

WHEREAS, it would be desirable to undertake a more comprehensive redevelopment project downtown with the library as a key component; and

WHEREAS, the preliminary work to explore the feasibility of this approach and the interest from the development community would cost approximately \$12,000; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Executive has indicated his interest in sharing the cost of this preliminary work with the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salisbury City Council hereby appropriates \$6,000 from the City's Contingency to fund the City's share of this study.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Mayor Barrie P. Tilghman is authorized and empowered to execute on behalf of the City any and all documents required to secure the services of the consultant selected to perform this work.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on 27<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2008 and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
