

RESOLUTION NO. 1662

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY,
MARYLAND ENDORSING REQUEST FOR LEGISLATIVE ACTION BY THE
MARYLAND MUNICIPAL LEAGUE

WHEREAS, the Maryland Municipal League (MML) each year requests input from its member municipalities on items of interest to municipalities statewide that should be brought before the next session of the General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the MML reviews all requests received and selects several items to which it will give priority support during the legislative session; and

WHEREAS, the following matters, which have statewide application, are of particular concern to the City of Salisbury and require legislative action;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salisbury City Council endorses the following requests for legislative action by the Maryland Municipal League:

“The City of Salisbury requests that the General Assembly pass legislation in FY 2009 to establish a study commission in FY 2010 to look into and report its findings on municipal government revenue structures to reduce the reliance on property taxes.”
