A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING STATE GRANT FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION FOR TRAINING, OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT AND CONTINUATION OF PROGRAMS TO ENHANCE COMMUNITY POLICING EFFORTS AND QUALITY OF LIFE ISSUES IN THE DESIGNATED CSAFE II AREA.

WHEREAS, the Salisbury Police Department is family-focused, culturally competent, and responsive to the strengths, needs and priorities of families and children in the City of Salisbury; and

WHEREAS, this State grant was awarded by the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention through the Wicomico Partnership for Families and Children for CSAFE II initiatives in the Westside neighborhoods of Salisbury; and

WHEREAS, through this grant, these funds will provide for police officer overtime, training and the continuation of the Earn-A-Bike program and the National Night Out event in the CSAFE II area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that awarded State Grant funds in the amount of \$7,000, be used for overtime assignments and programs in the CSAFE II area.
