

RESOLUTION NO. 1700

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, ACCEPTING FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH A GRANT FROM COMMUNITY PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS FOR A RECREATIONAL PROJECT IN THE CITY OF SALISBURY.
