
WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury applied for grant funds through the Maryland Department of Natural Resources to fund the cost of design and construction of fuel tanks at the Port of Salisbury Marina, and;

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Natural Resources approved the City's Waterway Improvement Fund Application & Project Agreement to fund these improvements at the estimated cost of \$99,000.



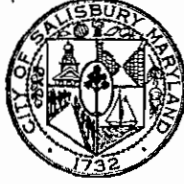


